For Under Graduate studies (Bachelors)

Eligibility Criteria

Scholarship Applications for undergraduate studies are open only for female Afghan refugee youth and non-Afghan refugee (Male & Female) youth.

- Valid Refugee Status.
- Age between 17 to 30 years.
- Holding a Higher Secondary School Certificate (HSSC/Intermediate) or Equivalent.
- Candidate must be enrolled in HEC recognized institute.
- Candidate must have at least 60% marks in last examination.
- The applicant must be the only beneficiary of DAFI from his/her family.
- The applicant should not be receiving any other academic scholarship.
- Strong motivation to contribute towards refugee/host community.
- Interest in a professional qualification.
- Female candidates and refugees with different needs would be given preference.

Required Documents

- Completely filled and signed DAFI Application Form.
- 2 passport size pictures.
- Copy of Valid POR/UNHCR Refugee card.
- Copy of Matriculation and intermediate certificates with DMCs.
- Equivalence Certificate for students who have studied from Afghan schools.
- Proof of enrollment in institute (Admission Letter/ Bonafide Letter) and last examination transcript.

For Techinical Education (TVET) - Programme

Eligibility Criteria

Scholarship applications for technical education are open for refugees (male & female) of all nationalities.

- Valid POR/UNHCR Refugee card holder.
- Age between 16 to 30 years.
- 10th grade (Pakistani school system)/ 12th grade (Afghan school system).
- Enrollment in technical education diploma with at least 50% marks in previous examination.
- Field of study that has high probability of employment either in home or host country.
- Candidate must be enrolled in a TVET institution.
- The applicant must be the only beneficiary of DAFI from his/her family.
- The applicant should not be receiving any other academic scholarship or support.
- Strong motivation to contribute towards refugee/host community.
- Female candidates and refugees with different needs would be given preference

Required Documents

- Completely filled and signed DAFI Application Form.
- 2 passport size pictures.
- Copy of Valid POR/UNHCR Refugee card.
- Copy of Matriculation certificate for students from Pakistani school and copy of Shahadatnama for students from Afghan school.
- Proof of enrollment/Admission Letter in Technical Institute.

Important Information

- -The applications are open for female Afghan refugee youth and non-Afghan refugee youth (male & female) for undergraduate studies. In addition, applications for technical education are open for refugees of all nationalities.
- -Please note that only shortlisted candidates will be contacted on the numbers and emails provided in the application forms and will be invited for interviews in Islamabad, Peshawar, Karachi and Quetta respectively.
- -Pakistani students are not eligible for the scholarship. Students trying to influence the selection process will be automatically disqualified.
- -Applicants who are already availing any other scholarship (HEC, Allama Iqbal, HSSP, and NAVTTC) programme are not eligible to apply.
- -UNHCR/Inspire Pakistan Reserves the right to cancel the scholarship in case of misrepresentation of information or documents.
- -Please note that application forms are free of charge. Incomplete and late application forms will be not entertained.
